APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous session made by Jeff Sparks, 2nd by Linda Bedwell. 4 ayes, passed.

APPROVAL OF CLAIMS PROPERLY SIGNED

A motion to approve the claims properly signed by Tony Richards, 2nd by Jerry Ellett. 3 ayes, passed.

APPROVAL OF FUND & APPROPRIATION REPORT

A motion to approve the fund and appropriation report made by Linda Bedwell, 2nd by Tony Richards. 4 ayes, passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Ordinance #2021-06 (Wastewater Rate)

A motion was made by Jeff Sparks to approve the new proposed rates in Ordinance 2021-6, 2nd by Linda Bedwell. 4 ayes, passed.

Ordinance #2021-07 (2022 Budget)

A motion was made by Linda Bedwell to make an amendment to the 2022 budget, her amendment was to change the Cemetery Superintendent line item from \$35,000 down to \$33,000, motion failed due to lack of 2nd.

A motion was made by Tony Richards to make an amendment to the 2022 budget, his amendment was to change the Cemetery Superintendent line item from \$35,000 down to \$33,300, 2nd by Jerry Ellett. After discussion Richards asked to rescind his motion, Linda Bedwell objected. 2 ayes, passed.

A motion was made by Linda Bedwell to approve the amended 2022 budget, 2nd by Jerry Ellett. 3 ayes, passed.

Mayor Wilkes stated he did not approve of the amended budget with the Cemetery Superintendent line item being changed and he intended to veto it.

Declaratory Resolution (IMPA Tax Abatement)

A motion was made by Jeff Sparks to approving the declaratory resolution designating an economic revitalization area (IMPA Solar Field) and fixing a date, time, and place for a public hearing (Linton City Hall November 8 5:45 p.m.) for the Indiana Municipal Power Agency, 2nd by Linda Bedwell. 4 ayes, passed.

A motion was made by Tony Richards to approve close the Section of Vincennes Street in front of the Carnegie Arts Center and 1st in that same section to the alley way south of Tim Meeks financial office for the safety of those attendee the festival, 2nd by Jerry Ellett. 4 ayes, passed.
